

Medstead Players Constitution

1. That this Society should be called the Medstead Players.
2. That the Executive of the Society shall consist of nine members:
 - Chairman
 - Vice Chairman
 - Hon. Secretary
 - Hon. Treasurer
 - Social Secretary
 - Publicity Officer
 - Village Hall Management Committee Representative
 - Member from the Floor
 - Junior Member
3. That the object of this Society is to promote local interest in the work of live amateur theatre.
4. That a President & Vice President shall be proposed by the executive.
5. That an Extraordinary General Meeting may be called at the request of any member providing 14 day's notice is given, and the purpose for the meeting is stated on the notice.
6. That no alteration to the Rules may be made unless decided by a 2/3rds majority present at any General Meeting and providing a notice of intention of the meeting is given to members.
7. That no alteration to the Constitution be made unless approved by at least 60% of the total membership.
8. That in the event of the Club being wound up the methods of distributing assets should be decided at an Extraordinary General Meeting.

Rules

1. That the annual subscription upon joining should be £3.00 for adults and £1.00 for under 18. Members are entitled to participate fully in the activities of the club. For members joining half way through the year, a pro rata deduction should be made.
2. That the Club should be considered formed on the election of officers and that the first AGM should be held within a period of 18 months from that time. Thereafter the AGM shall be held annually, 14 days notice being given to all members.
3. The Committee shall meet monthly at least. A quorum shall consist of 2/3rds of total Committee but not less than four members.
4. That all of the officers and Committee members shall retire at the AGM but be eligible for re-election. The Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer shall not hold office for longer than three consecutive years. No member shall serve on the Committee for more than five consecutive years. A member may be re-elected to Committee after one years absence. In exceptional circumstances a Committee member, Chairman, Secretary or Treasurer can have their term of office extended by up to one year by the approval of a 2/3 rds majority of members present at an AGM or EGM. Only fully paid up members are eligible to vote.
5. That the funds of the Society should be used only for the stated object, and no payments made to any member of the Society for services other than for legitimate expenses incurred.
6. That once rehearsals start, the Producer shall be solely responsible for the production and shall be empowered to make changes in the cast should it be considered necessary or for absenteeism from rehearsals without warning, or to remove a player from the cast. The Committee shall be informed of such action.
